Ride Cancellation Policy

RBC Rides are canceled for the following reasons:

- A public authority (local, county or state) declares an emergency / dangerous / no unnecessary travel conditions in the area of the ride.
- The Air Quality Index (AQI) exceeds 150.
- Weather conditions are decidedly unsafe.

If weather is questionable, please initiate discussion in the Meetup event. Delaying a ride by a few hours may be desirable. If a ride is remote (>1h drive), discussion can save a lot of time for everyone (including the ride leader) if no one is likely to go. If no one RSVP's to a remote ride, the ride leader does not need to drive to the start. If the ride is local, please be at the start to sign people in even if you don't plan to ride.

Ride leaders are expected to find substitutes in the event a conflict arises and they cannot lead a ride. This is especially important for Supported Rides (SR) since the ride leader sweeps the ride (or arranges for it to be swept by others).

If a ride leader is unavailable due to unforeseen circumstances and there is no declared substitute, riders can still enjoy the ride themselves. A Ride Waiver must still be circulated so that the liability protection and insurance benefit is in effect for participants. With SR rides, participants should decide who will assume the sweep function.
